**Arthur Schwartz** is the deputy executive director and general counsel of the National Society of Professional Engineers, and he also serves as the executive director of the National Academy of Forensic Engineers, an NSPE affinity group. His responsibilities include serving as staff director to the NSPE Board of Ethical Review, the Committee on Policy and Advocacy, the Professional Liability Committee, and the Engineers Joint Contract Documents Committee. Schwartz has authored more than 400 published ethics decisions.



This session will cover a variety of engineering ethic subjects including protection of the public health and safety, conflicts of interest, professional competence, obligations to employer/client, confidentiality and other key ethical, licensure, professional practice, risk management, contract and legal issues. Following an overview of ethics principles, Schwartz will interactively review and discuss a series of ethics case studies with attendees.

In addition, **Dr. Alejandro Angel, P.E.**, current board member on the Arizona State Board of Technical Registration, will be the luncheon speaker presenting a timely update regarding the status and activities of the Board; plus, how the Board handles ethics complaints and violations.
