Forensic engineers are the “CSI’s” of the legal system when engineering issues arise during claims or litigation. Forensic engineers may be involved in the investigation and analysis of an accident or other type of claim in which an engineering analysis is required. Forensic engineers also advise and mentor their clients about relevant engineering issues. In addition, forensic engineers may be called upon to testify as “expert witnesses” during a trial or an arbitration proceeding. Most importantly, forensic engineers act in an objective role, rather than as an advocate.

This seminar is designed to introduce the concept of forensic engineering to those who may be interested in expanding their scope of engineering practice. Basic qualifications and credentials for forensic engineers will be presented. Also, for those considering this profession, some of the *good* and *bad* you can expect from a forensic engineering practice.
